

Common Course Numbering (CCN) Changes

As of Summer Quarter 2008, the Seattle Community Colleges are using a new **Common Course Numbering (CCN) System**. The new system is designed to identify courses that are equivalent at community colleges across the state and to make it easier for students who may transfer between two-year colleges.

Some of the Seattle Community Colleges course numbers and titles have been changed to comply with this new system. This list shows the courses that have been changed.

Courses identified with an ampersand (&) are part of the CCN system. However, courses without an "&" will continue to transfer between two-year and four-year colleges under individual Direct Transfer Agreements (DTA), as in the past.

Changes may include one or more of the following:

- All prefixes in a subject area may change.
Example: all ANT courses become ANTH.
- Prefix plus "&". These courses are now part of the state's CCN system.
Example: AST 100 to ASTR& 100.
- Prefix change to new prefix subject area.
Example: ANP 128 to BIOL 128.
- Course number change to fit new CCN system.
Example: ACC 210 to ACCT& 201.
- Course title change to fit new CCN system.
Example: ANT 201 Physical Anthropology to ANTH& 205 Biological Anthropology.

NOTE: These changes will be identified when you use the new course designation to look up the course in this catalog or on the web.

If a subject area prefix does not appear on the following list, it is not affected by the CCN system at this time, and all those course designations remain the same.
